October 29, 2008 – The Hawaii Bicycling League (HBL) supports the City’s rail Charter Amendment, which asks “Shall the powers, duties, and functions of the City, through its director of transportation services, include establishment of a steel wheel on steel wheel transit system”.

In the 2006 Charter Amendment 8, 77% of Honolulu residents deemed it a priority for the City to be pedestrian and bicycling safe. New bicycle, transit, and pedestrian facilities can improve the mobility and access of a wide range of individuals, while stimulating economic and community development. Together with the City’s implementation of the Master Bicycling Plan, we can realize the vision of a bicycle friendly city and safe, livable communities.
